Lessons Learnt:

 Wide engagement of citizenry through consultative meetings improved process and were key to building trust and openness.

- Consultative meeting with MCERT and GCERT on review of cyber security strategy
- Follow up with task force on status of review of digital laws and drawing of stakeholder meeting schedule to discuss proposed amendments
- Follow up with Foreign Affairs on status of ratification

Commitment 4: Promote citizen utilisation of ict in accessing information to make service delivery transparent, responsive, and accountable

Actions and Activities completed:

- Provision of free public wi-fi to 32 institutions
- Last mile connectivity provided in underserved areas
- Maintenance of government MDA websites and all their official social media pages/sites
- Creation of Malawi OGP website.

Outputs delivered

- 32 sites connected
- 28 towers operational and equipment for 3 towers is in country now awaiting installation.
- OGP website created

Lessons Learnt:

- Continued collaboration with the private sector is key to further access
- Digital government rides on the backbone of connectivity
- Strengthened communication with MDAs for provision of updated content for their websites is needed.

Next Steps:

- Stakeholder consultation for connectivity initiative to be done under the Digital Acceleration Project to be done to identify sites for connection.
- Continued communication with Treasury to continue communication tower installation in underserved areas.
- Follow up with TWGs for content for OGP website
